Features:

A pleasant walk of approximately 2 miles along the River Trent in Burton Joyce, a busy village close to Nottingham.

- The walk features a pocket park with seating.
- Another Break Free 2 Route, Colwick Country Park, is close by.

Opening Times:

This route based walk has open access.

Location:

Paths and gates:

- Paths are mostly level and grassy (B) but take care crossing bridges which are uneven and eroded.
 The path adjacent to the railway line are paved and suitable for wheelchairs.
- Gates are marked (**G**), use the Radar key scheme, and are easily opened.
- A stile along the river and flooding from time to time prevents access by wheelchairs at this point.


